# Changes to traffic conditions in Bulleen



September 2025

From 19 September to 6 October, there will be changes to traffic conditions at the Manningham Road and Bulleen Road intersection, and Bridge Street in Bulleen.

## What you need to know:

- 1 Manningham Road and Bridge Street full closure, overnight only, from 7pm to 9am, Friday 19 September to Sunday 21 September.
- 2 Bulleen Road southbound closed between Manningham Road and Noelle Street, and reduced lanes on Manningham Road and Bridge Street, from 8pm Friday 19 September to 6am Friday 26 September and from 8pm Tuesday 30 September to 6am Monday 6 October.

## Detours during these closures:

- Overnight only from 7pm to 9am, Friday 19 September to Sunday 21 September
- From 8pm Friday 19 September to 6am Friday 26 September, and from 8pm Tuesday 30 September to 6am Monday 6 October


Traffic management and detours will be in place to guide road users safely through the area. Road users can expect delays of up to 40 minutes.

### Eastern Freeway and M80 disruptions

Throughout September, there will also be disruptions along the Eastern Freeway and M80 Ring Road. Eastern Freeway full weekend closure both directions between Doncaster Road and Tram Road from 10pm Friday 5 September to 5am Monday 8 September. Significant delays of up to 90 minutes are expected.

M80 Ring Road closed in both directions between Plenty Road and Greensborough Bypass, and the Greensborough Bypass between Diamond Creek Road and Grimshaw Street from 7.30pm, Friday 19 September to 5.30am, Monday 22 September. Delays of up to 60 minutes are expected.
